



TBAS Junior Referee Conversion Form

General Guidelines

Any person holding a Junior Referee license may apply for conversion to a National Referee license.

Conversion Procedure

In order to convert your Junior Referee license to a National Referee license, you are required to:

- Be 18 years of age (according to the date of birth)
- Actively officiating (at least two competitions) within the past one year

You may officiate at any TBAS organized events to achieve the required number of competitions. Upon meeting the requirement, you may then proceed to apply for the conversion by submitting this completed form (in person, email, fax or scan) with the relevant documents.

The following are required when applying for the conversion of license:

- Conversion of Junior Referee License Application Form
- Admin Fee of \$50 (Cash or Cheque payment only)
